



Topic: Summer Camp Scam Alert

Purpose: The purpose of this communication is to alert families about fraudulent billing schemes.

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) is alerting families about fraudulent billing schemes involving certain summer camps and recreational programs advertised as free or low cost for children with Medicaid.

Some of these programs use the ODM logo in their marketing. Please note that ODM does not endorse, promote, partner with, or collaborate with any summer camp or recreational program.

These programs have been diagnosing children with a mental health condition solely to bill for these services—often without the knowledge of the child or their parent or guardian. This practice is unlawful.

OhioRISE does not endorse or promote any summer camp or recreational programs.
