Our Quick Payment Program for FQHC and RHC Providers

What is the Quick Payment Program?



The Quick Payment Program is a program designed specifically for our Virginia Federally Qualified Health Centers and Rural Health Clinics providers to improve provider cashflow and financial stability, as well as to ensure prompt claim payments.

How does a provider sign up for the Quick Payment Program?

It's easy! First, enroll through our ECHO Health Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA) enrollments system, and elect to receive EFTs and electronic remits. To get started, visit

How does the process work?

Once you're set up to receive EFTs through ECHO, daily EFT payment transmissions are sent to your bank. Your bank must be able to accept next-day EFT payments. You may have to change banks if your current financial institution does not process next-day payments.

If you're not set up for EFT payments and elect to receive a paper check instead, the paper checks will be mailed out the same day as the electronic payments are sent to the bank.
